Available Booking Options

Individual Dancer: Portraits for one dancer (one costume).

Siblings: Siblings pose together; no individual portraits (one costume each).

Add-On Bookings:

- For an additional costume (e.g., for multiple roles).
- Add another individual dancer from the same family.
- Include a Siblings package at the add-on rate after booking an Individual Dancer or additional costume.

Portrait Package Details

Price: \$90, includes:

- **2 Standing Poses:** Capture the elegance and poise in classic standing poses.
- **1 Close-Up Pose:** Highlight the intricate details with a stunning close-up.
- **Private Online Viewing Gallery:** Conveniently view your photos in a secure online gallery with a shopping cart feature for easy ordering.
- **\$100 Product Credit Coupon:** Enjoy a \$100 credit towards any of our prints, products or digital images.

Add-On Bookings: \$75

- Includes everything above.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What are Nutcracker Ballet Portrait Sessions?

Nutcracker Ballet Portrait Sessions are exclusive photography sessions designed to capture dancers in their Nutcracker costumes and roles. These sessions provide a beautiful keepsake for dancers and their families, with images that reflect the artistry and magic of the Nutcracker ballet.

2. Who can book a Nutcracker Ballet Portrait Session?

Sessions are available for all cast members.

3. How do we book a session?

You can book a session using the link above. Separate bookings will need to be made for Add-Ons. **When booking multiple packages, book only one \$90 package. Each additional package will be \$75.** *You must pay for each package before booking another.*

4. Where are the sessions held and when should I arrive?

Sessions will be at Dallas Ballet Center in Studio D (tap studio). Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time to allow for time to change into costume.

Do not schedule portraits during your rehearsal.

5. How do I secure my costume?

Please provide your dancer's name and role in the "Notes for Sarah & Ron" when you book. Once you book your session, we will provide DBCo with your booking information and costumes will be ready prior to your portrait session.

6. How should dancers prepare for the session?

- **Hair and Makeup:** Dancers should arrive with stage hair and makeup completed.
- **Accessories:** Character props will be available.
- **Posing Ideas:** Consider a few signature poses in character to help make your photos special. We will, of course, assist in getting great poses.

7. Can family members or friends join the session?

Yes. Use the "Add On" booking option to schedule a session with a sibling or a friend.

8. When will I receive my photos?

Galleries will be shared within 1-2 weeks after the session. Print and products will be delivered directly to your address within 1-2 weeks from ordering.

9. What can I purchase from my gallery?
